This agreement may be cancelled in writing. Under this agreement FAMILY TO FAMILY ADOPTIONS, INC. may provide services such as temporary housing, reasonable costs for transportation to and from services, adoption counseling, assistance with pre-natal care, and other maternity related expenses. A detailed needs assessment will be done to determine which, if any, of these services are required by the client.

You will be assigned a maternity caseworker and regular counseling sessions will be set up for you. Please call 281-342-4042 or 1-800-385-6301 during working hours for casework and counseling appointments and these same numbers after hours for emergencies only.
