



## Certification of Indian Heritage

Any child having substantial American Indian heritage must, by law, have a release from their tribe before being placed for adoption.

Consequently, if you, your parents, or grandparents are “Registered Card Holders” of an Indian tribe, Family to Family Adoptions, Inc. will the following information from you and or the registered relative:

Address and Location of Indian Tribe

If you have only ‘some’ Indian heritage, but neither you nor your family members are registered card holders of a tribe, the above information is not required.
